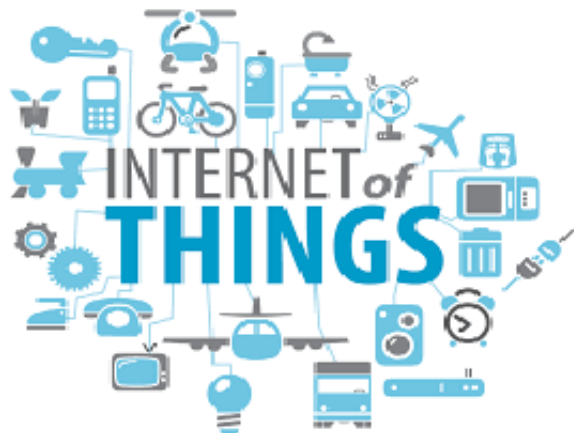

Professor Anu Gokhale, Department of Technology, Illinois State University, USA

Dr. Anu A. Gokhale has completed twenty-five years of university teaching and is currently a professor and coordinator of the computer systems technology program at Illinois State University. She is named Fulbright Distinguished Chair in STEM at the University of Pernambuco, Brazil, 2016-17; is a Fulbright Specialist; and was a Fulbright Scholar to India in 2002. She was honored with the 2011 University Outstanding Researcher Award. Originally from India, she has a master's in physics–electronics from the College of William & Mary, and a doctorate from Iowa State University. She presents and publishes her peer-reviewed research, and pursues multi-year projects funded by agencies like the US Department of Education, US Department of State, and National Science Foundation. The current NSF funded project is in Computing Education for the 21st Century. She authored a second edition of her book Introduction to Telecommunications, which also has an international edition in Chinese. She continues to be an invited keynote speaker at various
